Lunch Money


It is with regret that I have to remind parents/carers again about paying lunch money. We are having an increasing number of pupils that do not bring their lunch money with them either on the day or in advance. If your child is down for a school meal and does not bring their lunch money with them, you will be contacted by the school and asked to bring it in or provide a packed lunch.

If lunch money arrears are not paid, you will be contacted by the Legal Department. The school is unable to sustain these arrears.

Please make sure you keep up to date with your child's lunch money payments.

Year groups 3-6 currently only pay 50p per day for school meals.

Attendance

Attendance improved slightly last week. Absences are due to holidays and still due to illnesses causing a fall in attendance. As long as your child has not been sick or has diarrhoea, they are able to come to school. Parents are welcome to come into school throughout the day to administer medication if this is required. 
