Lunch Money

It is with regret that I have to remind parents/carers again about paying lunch money. We are having an increasing number of pupils that do not bring their lunch money with them either on the day or in advance. If your child is down for a school meal and does not bring their lunch money with them, you will be contacted by the school and asked to bring it in or provide a packed lunch.

If lunch money arrears are not paid, you will be contacted by the Legal Department. The school is unable to sustain these arrears.

Please make sure you keep up to date with your child's lunch money payments.

Year groups 3-6 currently only pay 50p per day for school meals.

Parents / Carers are not permitted to enter the car park at any times of the day unless alternative arrangements have been made with the academy. You must leave your car on the road outside of the academy and not on the grass verges. We are working closely with the parking enforcement section at Hull City Council and they are currently monitoring the parking outside of school!
