### Attendance

Attendance has been very poor so far this academic year. Please do not keep your child off school if they have a headache or a cold/cough/temperature etc. These absences will not be authorised. Parents are welcome to come into school throughout the day to administer medication if this is required. Please encourage your child to attend school wherever possible. Thank you to all parents who get their children into school. If you are concerned about your child being poorly we have advice leaflets "Should my child go to school today" which are available from the school.

**Attendance for the year so far is 95.3%.**

**Last week's attendance was 92.1%**

Attendance is really important to ensure pupils get the best out of their education. Ofsted told us in January that the attendance of boys had to improve. This is something we will keep a very close eye on next year.

The national average is 96% attendance per week. Let's work together to beat the national average and ensure our children get the best education possible!

We will continue to monitor this closely.



### School Meal Costs

From 7th January 2018, the cost of school meals is increasing.

The cost of school meals will be as follows:

FS1 Nursery Pupils—will now be charged 50p per day for a school meal (on top of the supervision charge)

Year 3 to Year 6 Pupils—will now be charged £1.00 per day.

Pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 will continue to receive the Universal Infant Free School Meals as they currently do. There are currently no plans from the Government to change this!

School meals MUST be paid for in advance or on the day the child stays for a school meal. If meals are not paid for, you will be contacted requesting payment or you will be asked to bring a packed lunch for your child or take them home for lunch.

We are here to support you during this and can help you fill in any paperwork to claim free school meals. We are also very happy to check on your entitlement to ensure your child isn't missing any valuable funding.

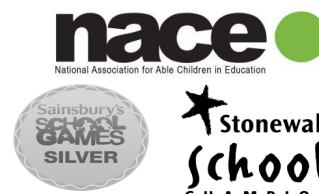

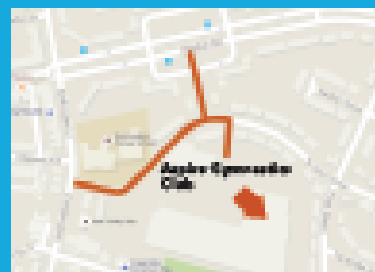
