## Changes to School Access and Office Opening Times

We have recently re-assessed how we keep our children safe at the times when they enter, and leave, the school site.

Because of this, we are making some changes to some of our procedures.

From Monday 4<sup>th</sup> February, office staff will not be available to talk directly to parents/carers/visitors at the times shown below.

**8:30-8:50**

**2:45-3:10**

During these times we will also be asking parents/carers/visitors to stay outside of the reception area so that children can move safely around the school.

Children who are arriving late can still be brought to the main school entrance where a member of school staff will meet them.

Could we also remind parents/carers of children in our Nursery, that children arriving for afternoon sessions should wait outside of the reception area and a member of staff will collect them.

At the end of the school day our Nursery children should be collected from the Foundation Stage door at 3:15.

We will no longer be allowing older siblings to leave through the Foundation Stage doors.

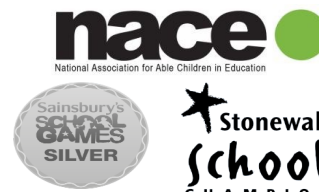

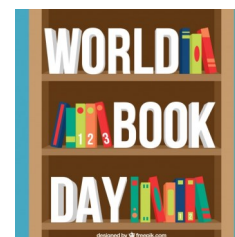
