Wider Curriculum

- At Stockwell Academy we follow the principles of the *Learning Challenge Curriculum.*
- The curriculum is built around the principle of greater learner involvement in their work. It focuses on pupils leading and getting involved in their learning, through engagement with a Big Question for each unit.
- Progression in the curriculum is evidenced through the development of key skills and essential knowledge, as well as the teaching of Maths, Writing and Reading basic skills across the whole curriculum.

- There are opportunities for whole school topics that allow cooperation between year groups, evidence of progression throughout the school and a chance to collaborate with and celebrate our local community.
